REQUEST FOR TRUST ACQUISITION

WHEREAS the Secretary of the Interior is generally authorized to accept land into trust for the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians under the Indian Reorganization Act, 25 U.S.C. § 465, and is explicitly required to accept land into trust for the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians in Emmet and Charlevoix Counties, Michigan, by the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians and the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Act, 25 U.S.C § 1300k-4 (a).

WHEREAS the Tribe has an interest in the following described parcel in Hayes Township, Charlevoix County, Michigan, which it desires to be held in trust for the Tribe by the Secretary of the Interior:

The East ½ of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 11, Township 34 North, Range 7 West.

WHEREAS the Tribe intends to use this parcel for development of housing in Charlevoix county northeast of the town of Charlevoix, where there is a critical need for housing for Tribal members.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa

Indians requests that the Secretary of the Interior accept this parcel in trust for the Tribe.
