Support of Inter-Tribal Council Grant Proposal to the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians has a clearly demonstrated dedication to meeting the health and human services needs of all of its members, especially its children. Funding of the proposal of the Inter-Tribal Council would provide necessary resources to ensure that critical services are met/enhanced and access to a comprehensive array of services is improved;

WHEREAS working in collaboration with other Tribes and Indian Organizations in strategic planning, program implementation and on-going evaluation for service enhancement lends a great deal of strength with regard to addressing the unique needs of our population;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians strongly supports the Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan's proposal for provision of services to children and adolescents with serious emotional disturbance and their families, and is committed to the specific objectives outlined in this proposal to the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration.
