## RESOLUTION 04069702

**TO SUPPORT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE (USDA) FOOD DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM ON INDIAN RESERVATIONS (FDPIR) FY 97 FOR THE CONTINUATION OF THE NUTRITION EDUCATION PROGRAM.**

**WHEREAS** the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians (LTBB) as stated in the preamble to our constitution and bylaws is charged with among other things the perpetuation of our way of life, the preservation of our cultural heritage, and enhancing the health and welfare of our tribal members;

**WHEREAS** the successful completion of the objectives in the USDA FDPIR Nutrition Education Program proposal would enhance the health of our tribal members, by continuing to educate and thus increase the awareness of good nutrition amongst our members;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council supports the submission of the proposal for a Nutrition Education Program Grant to the USDA. Tribal Chairman Frank Ettawageshik and Health Director Arlene Naganashe are hereby authorized to sign the necessary documents relating to this application.
