

**RESOLUTION 100800-01**

**DESIGNATION OF DELEGATE AND ALTERNATE  
DELEGATES TO THE NATIONAL CONGRESS OF AMERICAN INDIANS**

**WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, a federally recognized Indian tribe, reaffirmed by Public Law 103-324, 25 U.S.C. §1300k, is a member of the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI);

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians designates Tribal Chairman Gerald Chingwa as NCAI delegate at the NCAI Conference to be held November 12-17, 2000 and thereby authorizes him to cast votes on the Tribe's behalf, and designates Tribal Councilor Rita Shananaquet and Tribal Councilor Alice Yellowbank as alternate delegates and thereby authorized to cast votes on the Tribe's behalf when acting in that capacity.
