- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a federally recognized Indian tribe, as reaffirmed under Public Law 103-324, enacted September 21, 1994;
- WHEREAS** the Tribe wishes to ensure the future of the Tribe's presence on the Internet for the purpose of keeping its members informed;
- WHEREAS** the Tribal Council has determined that there is a need for a Tribally maintained web site;
- WHEREAS** the General Services Administration and the Department of the Interior's Indian Affairs Government initiative will allow federally recognized Indian tribes to participate in a program that will provide a domain name suffix identifying the Tribe on the World Wide Web as a government entity;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council approves the Internet Domain name registration of ltbbodawa.nsn.gov.
