WHEREAS the Tribal Health Department could wisely utilize such grant funds develop programs for the gathering of pertinent demographic information, teen-specific clinic/programs, and/or education;


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Health Department is authorized to prepare a grant application to IHS for the support of American Indian youth.

Certification


